2. Must I de-mand to right wrongs done to me? I'd be mer-ci-ful - as God has shown me!



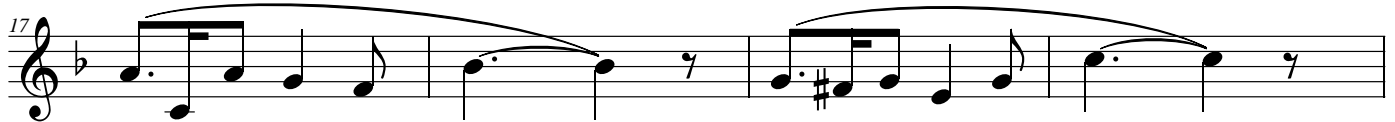
1. Should I pur-sue fleet-ing plea-sures on earth? I'd ra-ther mourn, and find com-fort in God!
2. Do I hide se-crets deep down in my heart? I'd stay pure and true -, that I may see God!



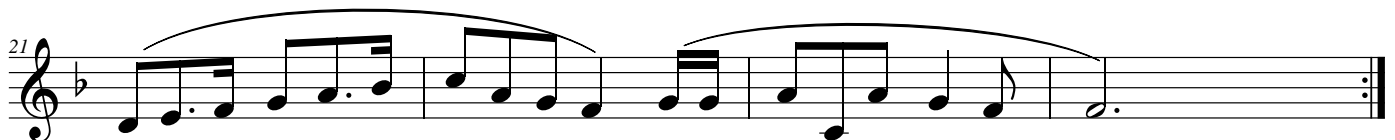
1. Would I strike down all who stand in my way? I would - be meek with God's un-fail-ing love!
2. Do I sow ha-tred in speech or in deed? I'd seek to make peace and bring glo-ry to God!



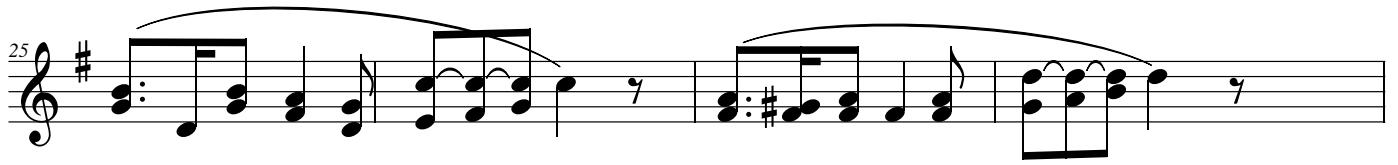
1. Should - I strive af-ter vain hopes and dreams? I'd hun-ger and thirst for God's righ-teous-ness!
2. Should I re-fuse to bear hard-ships in Christ? I'd draw on God's grace to re-joice in those trials!



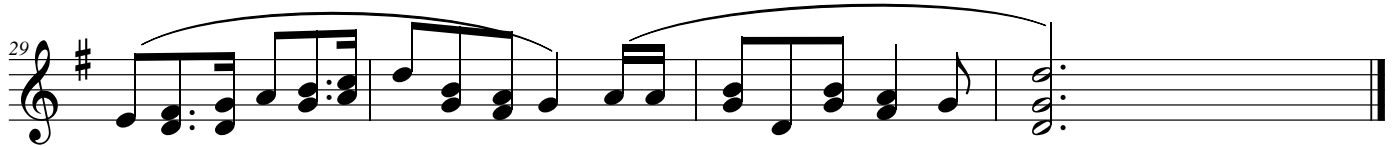
